

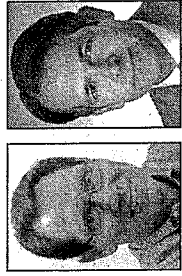

Engagement center: CHP assembled a task force to establish a center that will provide emergency shelter, safety and social engagement for publicly intoxicated individuals who do not have a home. Pending property availability and negotiations, implementation of existing plans call for a facility to open during 2011 with capacity for 12 people.

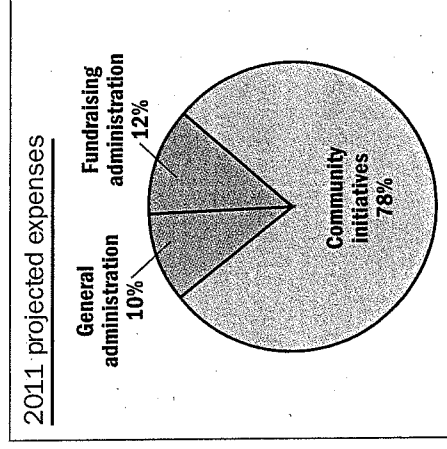
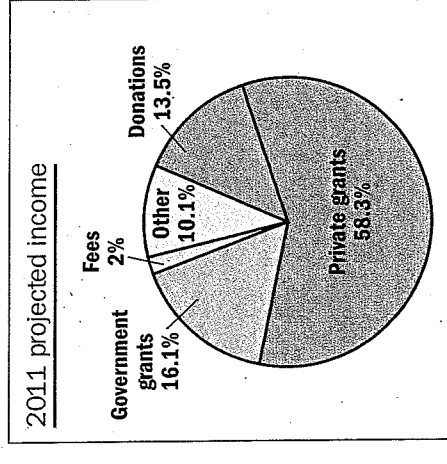
Youth Housing Initiative: Seeks to implement the Blueprint goal of providing sustainable housing and youth-centered transition services for homeless youth. CHIP is convening a task force with anticipated outcomes in 2011 to include community support for youth-centered supportive housing, completion of a business and service plan for a youth housing model, a viable location or locations identified for youth housing, and partners and funding support identified.
