PRIORITY ONE

Increase availability & access to safe, supportive, permanent housing

Decrease the number of unsheltered and long-term homeless neighbors by **65%** through the Streets to Home Indy Initiative.

PRIORITY TWO

Prevent returns to homelessness through consistent cross-system, holistic supportive care

Prevent returns to homelessness by ensuring that at least **95%** of formerly homeless individuals and families remain stably housed two years after placement, and by strengthening systemwide case management practices

PRIORITY THREE

Reduce the number of people entering homelessness

Reduce the number of people entering homelessness by ensuring that at least **90%** of engaged households are successfully diverted from the homeless response system

PRIORITY FOUR

Strengthen the homeless response system to reduce the impact of homelessness on overrepresented populations

Strengthen the homeless response system to reduce disparities, ensuring **65%** of referrals and move-ins reflect the residents experiencing homelessness in the Indianapolis community.
