# NOFO Update

## Timeline:

- **Jul. 3, 2025:** HUD announces intentions to public a new NOFO for FY2025
- **Nov. 13, 2025:** 2025 CoC NOFO is published with permanent housing and Tier 1 restrictions
  - Dec. 8, 2025: This NOFO was withdrawn to make revisions
- **Dec. 18, 2025:** Revised 2025 CoC NOFO is published for public review
- **Dec. 23, 2025:** U.S. District Court ordered HUD to take “all steps necessary to process eligible renewals for FY 2025 CoC funding pursuant to the FY24-25 NOFO but excluding the obligation of funding and the granting of any specific renewals”
  - This lawsuit is ongoing and there is no final judgment yet; NAEH hopes to receive a final judgment by the end of February (NAEH email – 01.09.26)
- **Jan. 8, 2026:** HUD notified CoC recipients of steps needed to begin processing renewals
  - Submission due on **February 9, 2026, at 8pm**; awards anticipated to be selected by late March 2026

# Instructions from HUD

Application submission process (as outlined in SNAPS email):

- Projects that were awarded FY24 funds (current projects) and are not being reallocated or replaced by the CoC are eligible for FY25 funds using their prior application submission and do not have to apply for renewal
- Applications for new projects created through CoC and/or DV reallocation or YHDP replacement must be submitted in eSnaps
- If a CoC is submitting applications for new or reallocated projects (including YHDP replacement), then the CoC must submit a priority listing

CoCs are not required to submit a consolidated application.

# Considerations

- Because HUD is processing applications under the **FY 2024 – FY 2025 Continuum of Care Competition and Renewal or Replacement of Youth Homeless Demonstration Program grants NOFO**, new projects types (TH, SSO) are ineligible for funding
- Projects eligible for new or reallocated funding are those that submitted new project applications by June 13, 2025
- If court order expires, then HUD will revert to the NOFO published in December
- Revisions will be made if there is opportunity to update eSnaps narratives
